

FY 2026 Mid-Year FM Standards Release Notes

May 15, 2026

Treasury's Bureau of the Fiscal Service (BFS) released FY 2026 Mid-Year updates to the federal financial management (FFM) business standards, which are included in the Financial Management Capability Framework (FMCF) and define baseline needs for solutions and services in the FM Marketplace.

The FY 2026 Mid-Year Release updates align the FM Standards components with changes to FFM systems and guidance and include feedback from Other Lines of Business (LoB), federal agencies and industry during multiple public comment periods.

A summary of the changes by topical area is included below along with references to impacted FM Standards components.

- ***Treasury Payments Management***

Expanded integration with Treasury payment systems by adding Treasury Do Not Pay Connect to the Core FS Pre-Built Business Information Exchange (BIE) list of required system integrations.

- ***Treasury Receivables and Collection Integration***

Expanded integration with Treasury Centralized Receivables Service (CRS) and the Collections Information Repository (CIR) by:

- Adding the Core FS Pre-Built BIEs FFM-CRS BIE and CRS-FFM BIE and updating the CIR-FFM BIE
- Implementing associated changes to the FFM Functions and Activities, Business Use Cases, Business Capabilities, and Core FS Pre-Built Business Reports

- ***Treasury G-Invoicing Integration***

Expanded integration with Treasury G-Invoicing by:

- Adding the Core FS Pre-Built BIEs GINV Org-FFM BIE, GINV GT&C-FFM BIE, FFM-GINV Order BIE, GINV Order-FFM BIE, FFM-GINV Perform BIE, GINV PerformSettle-FFM BIE, FFM-GINV 7600EZ BIE, and GINV 7600EZ-FFM BIE
- Implementing associated changes to the FFM Functions Activities and Business Data Elements

- ***Travel Line of Business Alignment***

Enhanced integration with GSA Go.gov by:

- Modifying Core FS Pre-Built BIE TRT-FFM BIE Assumptions
- Implementing associated changes to FFM Business Use Cases

- ***Public Feedback and FM Authoritative Reference Changes***

Based on public feedback and authoritative and other reference changes, updated the following FMCF components:

- FFM Functions and Activities
- FFM Business Capabilities (FFMSRs)
- FFM Business Data Elements
- Core FS Pre-Built Business Reports
- FM Solution/Service Evaluation Criteria
